Travel Vaccines

If you're planning to travel outside the UK, you may need to be vaccinated against some of the serious diseases found in other parts of the world.

Fill in one of our Travel Vaccines Forms and we can check if you require any vaccines. See the nurse or a private travel clinic at least 4 weeks before you're due to travel this is to ensure effective protection.

Are you pregnant? Why not apply for a medical exemption.

Its Hay fever season you can now buy tablets at your local pharmacy and most stores.

Did you know we can prebook appointments in advance.

Wanting a sick note and this is your first one, why not fill in a seven-day self cert, just ask one of our receptionists and they can provide you with the appropriate form.

Changed your address please let the practise know.

Call Back now live - No more waiting on hold - you can now keep your place in the queue, and we'll call you back when it's your turn. Please be aware that all telephone contacts with the practice are recorded for training and monitoring purposes.

Blood tests + Investigations - It is vital that patients have blood tests and investigations when instructed by a clinician. Blood monitoring is vitally important for certain medications and for long term conditions. Non-compliance may result in us altering your medication.

Cervical Screening

All women aged 25 to 64 are invited to cervical screening to check the health of their cervix

Cervical screening is one of the best ways to protect yourself from cervical cancer



Pharmacy first will enable community pharmacists to supply prescription-only medicines, including antibiotics and antivirals where clinically appropriate, to treat these seven common health conditions without the need to visit a GP.
